On July 12, 2023, the Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") requiring Respondent to complete two (2) hours of education in "patient record keeping" and six (6) hours of education in "responsible prescribing of controlled substances" within six (6) months and pay \$515.00 in costs of the proceeding within ninety (90) days.

Based upon the information of record, which includes proof that Respondent has now completed the education and submitted the payment for costs in full, the following is entered:

1. Respondent's license to practice dentistry (#4493-15) is hereby returned to full, unrestricted status.
