On July 13, 2023, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing (“Board”) issued a Final Decision and Order (“Order”) limiting Respondent’s multistate privilege to practice nursing in Wisconsin pursuant to licensure in Missouri. Respondent was required to complete four (4) hours of education in patient safety and/or patient care pursuant to the terms of the Order. Costs in the amount of \$1,395.00 were required to be paid.

Respondent has submitted proof that she successfully completed the required education and paid required costs. As a result, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent’s multistate privilege to practice nursing in Wisconsin pursuant to licensure in Missouri (license 2016023217), or licensure in any other Compact state, is returned to full unrestricted status.
2. All limitations and encumbrances upon Respondent’s privilege to practice in Wisconsin are removed.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
