On July 18, 2023, the Wisconsin Professional Counselor Section of the Marriage and Family Therapy, Professional Counseling and Social Work Examining Board ("Section") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's licensed professional counselor credential with certain terms and conditions including, but not limited to, completion of an assessment by an approved mental health provider experienced in evaluating health care practitioners' fitness for duty.

The Order further states that Respondent's license may be limited in a manner to address any concerns the Board has with the conduct set out in the Order's findings of fact and to address any recommendations resulting from the assessment.

On October 17, 2023, the Board reviewed and accepted the report resulting from Respondent's fitness for duty assessment. Based on the assessor's recommendations, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent's license professional counselor credential (#5483-125) is further LIMITED as follows:

- a. Within thirty (30) days of this Order, Respondent must demonstrate participation in mental health treatment including DBT with a treater approved by the Section or its designee. Beginning thirty (30) days from the date of this Order, Applicant shall arrange for Treater to submit formal written reports on a monthly basis to the Department Monitor.
- b. Respondent may petition the Section for full, unrestricted licensure upon demonstration of continuous, successful compliance with the terms of the order for at least six (6) months.
