
On August 10, 2023, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing (“Board”) issued a Final Decision and Order (“Order”) limiting Respondent’s registered nurse license and advanced practice nurse prescriber certificate. Respondent was required to complete ten (10) hours of education on the topic of imaging interpretation skills, and ten (10) hours of education on the topic of diagnostic skills and procedures pursuant to the terms of the Order.

Respondent has submitted proof that she successfully completed the required education and as a result the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent’s registered nurse license (license number 120236-30) and advanced practice nurse prescriber certificate (certificate number 1855-33) are returned to full, unrestricted status.
2. All limitations and encumbrances upon Respondent’s credentials are removed.
