On August 16, 2023, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") requiring Respondent to complete four (4) hours of education in "Wisconsin PDMP and Responsible Prescribing of Controlled Substances" within ninety (90) days and pay \$1,046.00 in costs of the proceeding within ninety (90) days.
