You are hereby notified that you are subject to a forfeiture of \$500.00 in accordance with Wis. Stat. § 101.88(3) because you engaged in electrical work without possessing the necessary credential in violation of Wis. Stat. § 101.862(2). This forfeiture must be paid within 30 days of the date of mailing of this Notice or enforcement action may be taken against you. In addition, you shall not be able to obtain or renew any credential listed in Wis. Admin. Code SPS Chapter 305 until this forfeiture is paid.

The forfeiture of \$500.00 shall be made out to the "Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services." Include in the memo line "22 COM 011" and send to the following address:

You are receiving this forfeiture because a Department investigation found by a preponderance of the evidence that you engaged in electrical work when you did not possess any electrical credential with the State of Wisconsin. The investigation found that you admitted to performing electrical work at W2678 Cty Rd WH, Malone, WI 53049 to the Department. This is a violation of Wis. Stat. § 101.862(2) and you are subject to forfeitures as allowed by Wis. Stat. § 101.88(3).

The Department afforded you an opportunity to respond and considered your response in its determination. The Department has considered all of the evidence and finds by a preponderance of evidence that you violated Wis. Stat. § 101.862.

The Department has the authority to enter a forfeiture of no less than \$25 nor greater than \$500 for each violation of Wisconsin statute or code. See Wis. Stat § 101.88(3). The Department finds a violation of Wis. Stat. § 101.862. Therefore, a forfeiture of \$500 is an appropriate forfeiture as set forth by statute.

You have the right to request a hearing on this matter by sending a request for hearing to the Department of Safety and Professional Services, Chief Legal Counsel, P.O. Box 7190, Madison, Wisconsin 53707-7190, which must be received by the Department no later than 30 days from the date of mailing of this Notice. Any review will be held in accordance with the requirements set forth in Wis. Stat. § 101.02(6). Such request for review shall set out specifically and in full detail every reason why this order is unreasonable, and every issue to be considered by the Department in the review.
