On September 14, 2023, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing (“Board”) issued a Final Decision and Order (“Order”) limiting Respondent’s professional nursing license with certain terms and conditions including, but not limited to, completion of an AODA assessment by an approved provider experienced performing such evaluations. The Order further states that Respondent’s license may be limited in a manner to address any recommendations resulting from the assessment.

On October 25, 2023, the Board Liaison reviewed and accepted the report resulting from Respondent’s fitness for duty assessment. Based on the assessor’s recommendations, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent’s professional nursing license (#156384-30) is further LIMITED as follows:
 - a. Respondent shall continue with medical management of opioid dependence remission with a treater approved by the Board or its designee.
