On October 12, 2023, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing issued a Final Decision and Order (Order) limiting Respondent's multistate privilege to practice nursing in Wisconsin pursuant to licensure in Alabama. Respondent was required to complete three (3) hours of education in "proper restraint use" and four (4) hours of education on "ethics in nursing" within ninety (90) days. Respondent was also ordered to pay \$1,132.00 in costs of the proceeding within ninety (90) days.

Based upon the information of record, which includes proof that Respondent has now completed the required education and submitted the payment for costs in full, the following is entered:

ORDER

- 1. Respondent's privilege to practice in Wisconsin pursuant to her multistate registered nursing license in Alabama (license #1-177810) is hereby returned to full, unrestricted status.
- 2. All limitations and encumbrances upon Respondent's privilege to practice in Wisconsin are removed.
 - 3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
