On March 9, 2017, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing (Board) issued a Final Decision and Order (Order) suspending Respondent's registered nursing license (license number 144219-30) and her advanced practice nurse prescriber certificate (certificate number 3769-33) for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her licenses are currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

Information submitted in support of Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens has been reviewed. Based upon the information of record, which demonstrates that Respondent is eligible for a temporary reduction at this time, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens is hereby GRANTED. Respondent's frequency is reduced to not less than fourteen (14) urine screens per year and one (1) annual hair test until she obtains employment as a registered nurse and/or as an advanced practice nurse prescriber, at which time the frequency will be increased to not less than thirty-six (36) screen per year.

2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.

3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
