On September 14, 2023, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period, effective on September 24, 2023. Respondent may petition for a stay of suspension after ninety (90) days, upon demonstrating full compliance with Sections C and D of the Order for the most recent 30 days.

Respondent's petition for an initial stay of suspension has been reviewed pursuant to the Order. Based upon the information of record, which demonstrates that Respondent qualifies for a stay of suspension at this time, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. The suspension of Respondent's professional nursing license (#162899-30) is hereby STAYED.
2. The stay is continuous, contingent upon Respondent's compliance with the terms and conditions of the Order.
