

Medical

Dental Assistant

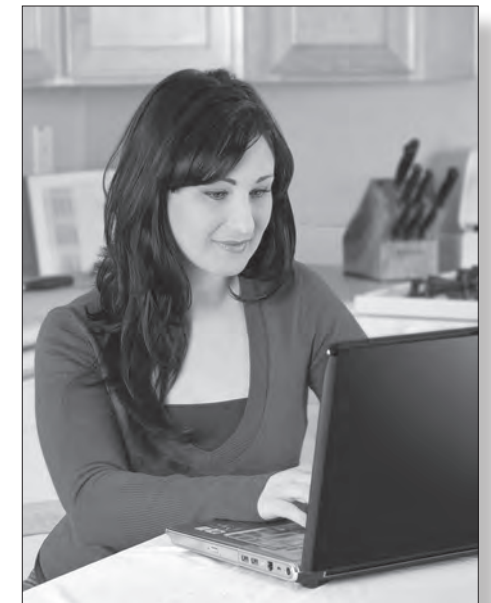
