Costs and Paying for a UAGC Degree

Liberty and patriot grants:

Eligible active duty service member students will have their tuition for all undergraduate courses reduced to \$250 per credit, and eligible student veterans will have their tuition for all undergraduate courses reduced to \$500 per credit. Tuition for doctoral courses will be reduced to \$500 per credit for eligible active duty service members and student veterans.
