Madison is known for being a popular university city with 6 universities and over 60,000 students. The city is set up to support students in academics and daily life.

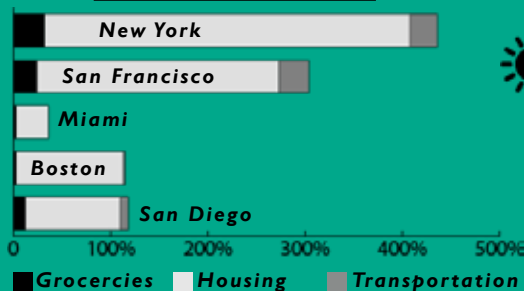
