

(7) I have carefully reviewed the red flag procedure located both in the Policy of Quality

issues or complaints that may arise during my time enrolled or any disciplinary actions I may
face by failing to adhere to Woolf's Community and Academic Standards. I understand that the
red flag procedure also governs areas of dispute resolution, but does not preclude the student
from seeking other legal remedies.
(8) By submitting my Agreement, I understand and acknowledge that in the event a member
college has provided an agreement which is in direct contradiction or cannot be rectified against
a term or provision of the Agreement that I will be bound and subjected to the requirements of
this agreement with the relevant term or provision severed from the member college agreement.
(9) I understand and agree that any dispute or claim arising out of, or in connection with this
agreement, breach thereof, or any unresolved disputes related to instruction provided to me
during the course of the Program, shall be settled by binding arbitration in the City and County
of San Francisco, California under the Rules of Arbitration of the International Chamber of
Commerce by three arbitrators appointed in accordance with said rules. Judgment on the award
rendered by the arbitrators may be entered in any court having jurisdiction thereof.
Notwithstanding the foregoing, either party may apply to any court of competent jurisdiction for
injunctive relief without breach of this action.
(10) I understand that if any term or other provision of this agreement is determined by a
court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, illegal or incapable of being enforced by rule of law
or public policy, such term or provision will be modified by such court to the minimum extent
necessary to make it valid and enforceable. If such modification is not possible, the relevant

for providing any and all instruction for the program that I have signed up for.

(5) I understand that the College is solely responsible for all admission criteria and
determines if I am admitted into the program that I am applying to. Information about admission
criteria and process are outlined in the Policy of Quality Assurance.
(6) I acknowledge that I have reviewed any Academic Handbook that the College has provided, if one should exist.
(7) I understand that the College may or may not offer employment or career services.
